Your Help is Needed!



From the President

At the June 20th Church Council meeting we began working with Pastor Paul Cannon. After only two days on the job, Pastor Paul got to know the council members a little better and added his experience to help in the decision making. Welcome to Trinity, Pastor, we're glad to have you here.



Since re-organizing after the February Annual Meeting, the council has not had a vice president. Jeremy Edson has agreed to serve in that capacity and was elected unanimously by his peers at the meeting. He will take over the presidency after the 2024 Annual Meeting. Thank you, Jeremy, for your willingness to serve.

One topic discussed at the meeting was to establish a group of volunteers, the Church Property Team, to help keep our church property looking its best. The work would involve keeping the landscaping weeded and trimmed which would probably be a twice per year commitment, usually spring and fall. When needed, the Team could also help on interior projects. If you are interested in helping with the general maintenance or have a special skillset that applies to maintenance of our other systems such as heating, cooling, plumbing, electrical, audio, computer, etc., please contact Office Manager Julie Morgan or Tom Hals.

The Congregation voted to purchase a vacant parcel adjacent to our cemetery at the last Annual Meeting. The parcel, which is approximately one-half acre in size, will be used to expand the cemetery in the future. This property purchase has been completed.

You may have noticed a slight change in the title of this article. While working on the property purchase, I read through Trinity's Constitution. According to that document, dated 2016, the officers of the congregation are to be a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer. Somewhere along the way the offices of president and vice president became chair and vice chair. In order to conform to our constitution, we will be using the titles president and vice president.
