Greetings Trinity Lutheran!

I wanted to take some time and introduce myself to you all before I officially begin on June 19th. I got to know some of you at the meet-and-greet back in March and I can't tell you how welcoming you were. Thank you for all the kind words.

EDGE High School Youth Ministry



Church Council Update

At our May 16th meeting the Council agreed to hire Pastor Jim Weckwerth as a Bridge Interim to serve our congregation on the first three Sundays of June. (The 4th, 11th and 18th). He will be starting on May 30th and working with our staff to make the transition to our newly called Pastor Paul Cannon as seamless as possible. Pastor Jim was recommended by the St. Paul Area Synod and has done many previous short term interims. Pastor Weckwerth will be available for urgent pastoral care such as hospital or hospice visits should that need arise during his three weeks with us. Our office staff has his contact information.



At that same meeting the Outreach Committee shared the results of Trinity's gifts as a member of THEE Alliance Forgiving Medical Debts. This organization started at Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Maple Grove and consists of 21 churches. To date Trinity has given \$6,256 to THEE Alliance. That amount has forgiven \$533,901 of medical debt and forgiven the debt of 794 families. Doing the math with those numbers, each dollar of money we have given has forgiven \$85.34 of medical debt and the average family medical debt of \$672.42 can be forgiven by \$7.88 of our giving. WOW!!!!! How heart-warming is that.

Viking Vittles

Viking Vittles will close out the 2022-2023 school year having distributed over 10,000 bags of food for the weekend that provided over 20,000 meals to students. In addition, care closets provided food, personal care items and school supplies to students in grades 6-12.

Trinity has housed and led this program since 2019. It takes many dedicated workers many hours each week to make this program a success. From ordering food to picking it up, setting up for packing, packing the bags, delivering the bags to the schools and putting the bags in student's backpacks. We are so fortunate to have a core group of volunteers that put in many hours each week as well as a host of community members willing to help out.

Summer distribution will start at Trinity on June 14th from 3-5 in the afternoon. It will be done at Stacy Lions Park starting on the 15th from 3-5 and in Central Park starting June 21 from 10-12. We are in need of volunteers to distribute at Trinity and at Central Park. Please sign up on the sheets on the bulletin board if you can help out.

While we do not distribute as many bags during the summer due to the need for families to pick them up we are able to offer fresh fruits and vegetables rather than the canned ones used during the school year. We continually strive to improve what we offer while keeping cost in mind.

As you can imagine providing all of this food to students in need is not an inexpensive undertaking. The annual cost is in excess of \$55,000. That is why we are kicking off a fundraising campaign that includes our brochures sent home with every student PK-5th grade as well as every staff member in the school district. Copies of the brochure are available on the Narthex table. We are also in the process of putting together a video that we hope to be able to take around to area churches, civic organizations etc. telling the story of Viking Vittles and asking for financial support. We continue to look for grants and any source of funding available. We are very pleased with the support Viking Vittles has received in the past and want to keep it going.



There is a special appeal underway to cover the costs of moving Pastor Cannon's family, which are estimated to be about \$7000.00. If you'd like to contribute, please note "Moving Fund" on the memo line of your check or offering envelope. We have collected about half so far. Thank you!
