Joy has worked as an outpatient chemical dependency counselor in a dual diagnosis program for adolescents. FROM THE President:

In your recent visits to our facility you have probably seen the new carpet in the hallway from the narthex to the kitchen and Sunday School rooms; it is hard to miss. There are some other recent improvements that are not quite as noticeable. The new entry tile at doors 4 and 13 and the new LED lighting in the chapel just to name a couple. The new carpet cleaning machine will probably be seen only by a few, but we hope the clean carpet it leaves behind will be noticed by all.



On the outside, the parking lot was swept and a tree service will be removing a dead spruce tree north of the narthex and about ten stumps from shrubs that were previously removed. On July 29th, five volunteers spent the morning working on the landscape areas and removed two pickup loads of weeds, branches, sticks and brush. While this work may go unnoticed, if left undone it could create a negative image.

At our August Council meeting the job description for the Director of Worship & Arts position and corresponding wage scale was approved as a prerequisite to advertising for someone for this job. We also reviewed attendance and financial numbers. Since Pastor Cannon started in June attendance at Sunday services and online views have increased. The monthly deficit in July decreased from prior months. On September 10th, "God's Work – Our Hands" Sunday, we are returning to services at 8:00AM (Traditional) and 10:00AM (Contemporary). Sunday School resumes that day as well.

Since the pandemic it seems that wherever you go there are "Help Wanted" or "Now Hiring" signs. Makes me wonder what happened to the work force. At Trinity a great amount of the work is done by volunteers, a time and talent ministry. Many people work in many different ways to get accomplish the mission of this church. There is always room for more, working on existing programs or starting new programs. Please volunteer, it will leave you with a feeling of satisfaction and a group of new friends.

Two members that have been very active in our congregation are moving in September. Steve and Mary Twitchell are moving to Northfield to be near their daughter and her family. Mary has served as a Worship Assistant, Chair of the Outreach Team and coordinated the last two visits of the Path Program. Steve has used his beautiful singing voice in our choir and many times as a soloist. On behalf of the entire congregation, I want to thank Steve and Mary for everything they have done for Trinity. We wish you well, we will miss you.
