> I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. 1 Corinthians 3:6

You should have received your stewardship letter by now (if you haven't yet, please go back and read it). In it, I wrote about what it means to grow in Christ. Part of that is growing as a church, welcoming new people through our doors and showing the love of Christ for those who are yet to come.

The other part is personal; it's how we grow in our giving. As a dad with three kids, I feel the stress of not knowing if I have enough whenever someone asks if I can volunteer or donate a little extra. I'm incredibly fortunate to be where I am, but between daycare, kids' activities, car payments, student loans, two full-time jobs and a mortgage, we don't often have a lot of extra time or money to give at the end of the month.

But if I'm honest, there's always something I can give. I don't have massive reserves of time or money, but on the margins I have a little extra. There may be a night or two I can volunteer for an activity. I can give an extra five dollars a week.

It's not a lot, but collectively it can make a big difference! If one hundred families gave an extra five hours a year to volunteering at church, or five dollars per week to the mission of the church, we would have five hundred extra service hours and an additional twenty-six thousand dollars in the budget! Imagine what God could do with that!

We trust that God can make big things grow from small beginnings. Whether it's a seed, a dollar or an hour of your time. And I trust God is making something new grow in you and here at Trinity Lutheran.

FROM THE President:

Over the past several months the Church Council has been developing a policy for outside or non-Church groups that allows them to sell on Church premises before or after services. This policy will be added to other Church policies developed over the years and kept on file in the Church office. To raise awareness of this policy it is printed here.



Policy for Selling at Church by outside (non-Church) Organizations

Organizations that are not a part of Trinity Lutheran Church will be permitted to sell on Church premises if all of the following conditions are met:

- 1. Schedule with Church office.
- 2. Organization is non-profit and for the betterment of the community.
- 3. People representing the organization and doing the selling are members of Trinity.
- 4. Selling would be done at a table so that buyers could approach the sellers (rather than sellers approaching potential buyers).
- 5. Selling would be limited to once per year for any organization.
- 6. Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts could sell for two consecutive Sundays per troop.
- 7. Where multiple Trinity members are doing the selling, credit for the sales within the organization is to be divided equally amongst those doing the sales.

This policy has been adopted by the Church Council and is now in effect. Hopefully it will resolve any conflicts related to who can sell and people feeling pressured into buying.
