Wandering Heart

Did you ever wonder why Easter is on a different day every year? It's not like Christmas (always December 25th) or even like Thanksgiving (always the fourth Thursday in November). Easter is always scheduled for the first Sunday after the full moon that occurs on or after the spring equinox (March 21st).

You read that right. Easter moves to a new spot (sometimes in different months!) every year because it's based on the lunar calendar. Therefore, Easter could potentially land on any Sunday between March 22nd and April 25th (according to the Old Farmer's Almanac). If that makes sense to you, congratulations! You're the first.

It's unnecessarily confusing, but the one small upside is that sometimes the change in date presents us with an opportunity to reflect on something new or something we hadn't thought of before. This year, Easter falls on March 31st, which is early as far as Easter goes. That means Ash Wednesday (the beginning of Lent), falls early as well – February 14th – Valentine's Day.

Ash Wednesday, the day we mark with ashes and a grim reminder of our mortality, will be on Valentine's day this year – a day of pink hearts, sweet candies, and doe-eyed professions of love. It's quite the juxtaposition.

But in a way, it seems appropriate too. In Lent our chosen theme is Wandering Heart – not the pink hearts of Valentine's, but our own wandering hearts. We will be following Peter's story from the time Jesus invites him to get out of the boat, through the highs and lows of his faith journey, all the way to the cross. We will be exploring how Peter's heart and faith ebbed and flowed, from determined loyalty, to betrayal, and back once again to faith.

And how our hearts wander! Maybe you see a bit of yourself in Peter. At times, our hearts are steadfast, and at times we waiver. But we trust that through it all, Christ remains true. God knows our hearts, and the Holy Spirit directs our ways as we wander through the wilderness of our lives.

Journey with us this season! Join us on Wednesdays (10:00a and 6:30p) and on Sundays as we walk with wandering hearts toward the cross.

First Communion Classes





From the Church Council

The Council had a pleasant surprise at the January meeting when Church Treasurer, Todd Fisk presented the financial reports. Due to generous giving in December, monthly income exceeded expenses for the month \$24,778.44. When the \$7,000 monthly support from Phoenix was included, our total deficit for 2023 was \$971.07. The budgeted deficit for 2023 was \$38,160. Ideally we need to operate without a deficit, but if we have to do so, a deficit of only \$971 is easier to swallow than one of \$38,160. Hopefully, we can improve our stewardship and have a balanced budget.



Another topic of discussion at the January meeting was the remodeling of the restrooms in the church portion of our building and adding handicapped facilities to both restrooms. We plan to get costs for these improvements and proceed if economically feasible.

Thank you to the following council members for their service this past year: Ann Tanko, Vicky Trampe, Stan Sjodahl, Aaron Nysse, Linda Born, Barb Nelson, Rosanne Johnson, Jeremy Edson and Todd Fisk. The terms of Ann, Vicky and Stan will expire as of the annual meeting. Ann and Vicky having served two consecutive 3-year terms. Jeremy has served as Vice-President the past year and will take over the presidential duties after the annual meeting. They have been an able and willing group to handle the duties of council of Trinity. It has been rewarding for me to have served with them.


