Dormant Easter Heart

Walking my daughter to the bus the other day, she spoke up and said, "Dad, a fancy word for hibernating, is dormant!" It occurred to me that both of those words seemed pretty fancy for a five (almost six) year old! I'll have to send a thank you letter to her school teachers!

And then she looked around at the bare, empty trees of winter that we pass on our stroll and said, "These trees aren't dead. They're just dormant." Wisdom from the mouths of babes!

As we continue through Lent with wandering hearts, and as we contemplate what the resurrection means in our lives, I wonder if we could consider that maybe faith never dies. If we can believe that a man died and came back to life three days later, then it should be no problem to believe that faith could possibly grow out of even the hardest of hearts.

Maybe faith never really dies. Maybe it's just dormant in some people.

We all go through peaks and valleys. No person's faith journey is a straight line (though some take more turns than others!). But as a people who profess the resurrection, we have to hold out hope that there is no such thing as faith that has extinguished (at least not truly!).

Spring will come. Buds will emerge on the branches. Life will bloom. And a dead man will walk out of a tomb. These are all signs that even a dormant faith may flower.

First Communion Classes


