

Some of you have talked to me about your adult children who have gone on to different churches and been re-baptized (something we don't do in the Lutheran church). I've talked with our youth about what it means for baptism to be a sacrament in the church. Like I said, there's been lots of interesting conversations!

Much could be said (and has been said) about baptism. We talk about it washing away our sin. We talk about baptism as being claimed in the family of God. We talk about it as putting our old selves to death, and rising to new life in Christ!

But at the end of the day, baptism is about one thing, and one thing alone: In baptism, you belong to God. It all boils down to that. From the moment you are baptized, you are claimed forever as a child of God, connected to Christ's death and resurrection through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Nothing you can do or say could ever add to it or take away from it. The promise of belonging to Christ is yours, given as a free gift.
