Stewardship Theme: Pray, Play and Practice What You Preach

Every Sunday, I gather with kids at the children's sermon time, and our prayer concludes with the words, "In your name we pray ... and play ... Amen!" It's a habit I picked up from Lutherdale, a Christian camp that I brought kids to at my last call.

Lately, I felt like something was missing from that formula. Yes, we pray together - we gather as a people of faith in word, music and worship! Yes, we play together – we come together to have fun, to support one another and to build each other up. But the prayer felt like it needed one more "P." And then it hit me: practice. We practice what we preach.

Viking Vittles

I would like to thank all the people that helped to pack the first week of Viking Vittles during God's Work Our Hands Sunday. We packed 258 bags in about 45 minutes with so many hands helping. It is such a blessing to see so much support for Viking Vittles.

During the summer Viking Vittles distributed 1,073 bags of food to families that are food insecure. This was done by distribution at North Branch Central Park, Trinity, Stacy Lions Park, and Sunrise Mobile Home Park. Many of these families expressed great appreciation for Viking Vittles.

We asked people to complete a short survey when they came to pick up food. This was to give us some feedback on the food we pack. The feedback we received was very positive and there were no items that were rated low enough for us to discontinue. We did however make a few changes to our menus as we begin the new school year. We are always looking for shelf stable items that are healthy and affordable to provide a variety to the families that get Viking Vittles.

As I write this the school year has only been in session for a very short time. Families are given the opportunity to sign up for Viking Vittles at the welcome conferences held the day before school starts. The number of students that sign up for Viking Vittles are provided to us from the various school offices as the enrollment forms are received. We do see a fair amount of fluctuation at the very beginning of the year. However, as of today we have 364 students signed up to get Viking Vittles each week this is up from the 252 we were packing at the end of last year. That is a 50% increase at Early Childhood and a 45% increase at Sunrise. We know hunger exists in our community but it is always eye opening to see the magnitude.

As we go through this school year with such an increase in need, we ask that you keep Viking Vittles in your prayers, both the families that are in need as well as all of the hands it takes to make Viking Vittles happen each week and for the financial support to keep Viking Vittles strong.


