Practice what we Preach (Yes, we do)

If you've been in church the last few months, you've heard us use the phrase, "Practice what we Preach." It was a focus of our stewardship campaign, but I want to take the time to share some numbers and stories behind that phrase, and how it can make a real impact.

One young mother with a newborn came to us a few months ago, because her husband injured himself working and was unable to get a job. At the same time, she wasn't working and had medical issues taking her away from work. Understandably, they couldn't afford their rent and many other bills.

She called the office one day, and we agreed to help her with money from the Pastoral Emergency Fund, and also with funds from our Outreach team. During her struggles we also helped the family purchase diapers, signed them up for a Thanksgiving meal from the Lion's Club, and even purchase a Christmas tree!

She was so moved by the generosity, that she texted one woman on our Outreach Team (who has been working with her on many of these things), "Would it be okay if I told you, I love you?" What began as a gesture of support, became a tangible representation of what it means when we say, "Love your neighbor."

This woman wasn't the only one we've helped. The Pastoral Emergency Fund, which we use to help folks who call asking for rental, heating or utility assistance has helped dozens of people in our community. By the numbers through December 10, 2024, we gave away over \$13,907 (and this is just ONE way Trinity helps our community).

Those dollars make a real difference in people's lives. The woman from our story has since been able to find work (along with her husband), and their family is getting back on her feet. We were able to help her, because Trinity is dedicated to practicing what we preach. The Gospel tells us to Love Your Neighbor, and we don't just say it, we do it.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES


