### Wonder of God

A few weeks ago, I quoted an astrophysicist in one of my sermons. Upon reflection, I wondered if it sounded strange for a pastor to be quoting an atheist scientist from the pulpit. It probably was a little irreverent in some ways; I'm sure the ghosts of reverends past were frowning down on me.

But often when I listen to scientists like Brian Cox or Neil deGrasse Tyson talk about the universe, with such a sense of wonder and humility at the sheer size and scope of the stars, to my ears it borders on the divine.

Sometimes I feel like we've lost that sense of wonder and humility when we consider God. Much of what you hear when you walk into most American churches today, is an emphasis on the personalness of God. God who is there for you. God who loves you. God who walks with you. These are all true and good things!

But you also have to hold that in tension with the vastness of God. In comparison with God, we are so small and insignificant. Our ancient ancestors in faith had that same sense of wonder and humility before God, "What are humans that you are mindful of them, mortals that you care for them?" asks the Psalmist (Psalm 8:4)

When we lose that sense of the awesomeness of God, then the personalness of God loses its meaning. If you don't realize how small and insignificant we are in comparison to the creator of the universe, then you won't ever understand what it really means that Jesus died for you.

We have to hold those two things in tension for it to have any meaning. As Easter approaches, we need that sense of reverence to truly understand what it means to have an empty tomb. To know that God cares for us on a personal level – enough to send his son to die on a cross – should truly humble us all.

Our God who created stars and galaxies, who sets to planets in motion, and cradles the universe like a mother hen, cares for you specifically. And that is a wonder to itself.

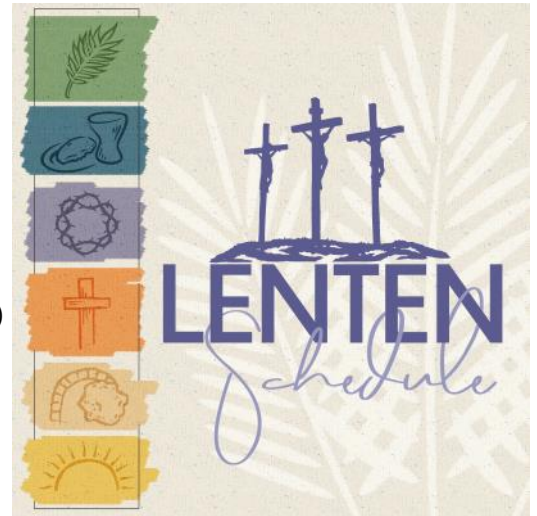

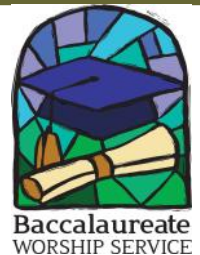
## Trinity Senior Recognition for Class of 2025

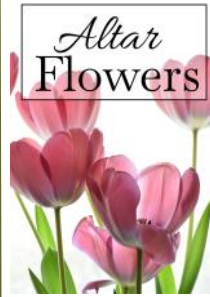

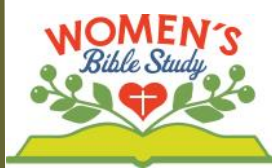
