Summer is here! I know that when each of you thinks of summer, something different probably comes to mind. For some, summer is getting the boat out on the lake. For others its time at the beach or by the pool. Or maybe it's family vacations and car trips!

In the church though, summer is the time for us to think about the Holy Spirit. Around this time every year, we celebrate a day in the church known as Pentecost. The day remembers when the Holy Spirit came down on Jesus' disciples (after Jesus had ascended into heaven) and rested on them with tongues of fire!

Then, perhaps an even stranger thing happened – the Spirit gave each of the disciples the ability to speak in different languages, so that all the diverse peoples of the world could understand and hear the Gospel. Of all the powers that the Spirit could have bestowed on those disciples (healing, walking on water, casting out demons), God chose something simple and profound – the ability to communicate.

But I don't think we should be surprised, because that's what the Holy Spirit does: the Spirit connects us. It sounds like an ordinary thing, but the power of connection is what gives life meaning. Language is how we shape the world around us; it's how we connect with one another. It's also how we connect with God – through word and prayer.

This summer, I hope you not only find sunshine and cool water, but I also hope you find a deep sense of connection with the people God surrounds you with. Just as critically, I hope the Spirit connects you to God through the Word - whatever beach you find yourself on.
