### God's Work, Our Hands Day

The ELCA (or Evangelical Lutheran Church in America) started "God's Work Our Hands" day in 2013 to commemorate the 25th anniversary and has since become an annual day of service for churches throughout the country. Churches who participate in this tradition, have generally taken the first Sunday after Labor Day to serve their neighbors in the community.

In other churches (and historically in the Lutheran Church as well), the longstanding tradition for that particular Sunday in September has long been "Rally Day" which focused on regathering people from their summer breaks to get back to church for Sunday School and regular worship.

And, I think that's good! We need this time to gather people back into our building, as we worship God. Gathering together gives life and energy to the Body of Christ in a way that strengthens us. But it says something about our church, that we aren't solely focused on bringing people IN, but we also spend time that day on reaching OUT.

That's how a healthy church should look; like breathing, it follows a pattern of deep breath IN and slow breath OUT. In and out. In and out. The Holy Spirit gathers us in as a people of God, but we shouldn't be solely focused on bringing people IN. Nor could the church survive if all we did was reach OUT. And so the Spirit compels us to draw people in, and to reach out to those in need, advocating for peace and justice in this world.

So we will begin our God's Work Our Hands Sunday (September 7th, 8am and 10am) by doing both! We hope to gather many people into worship and Sunday School, and between services, we'll have opportunities for folks during coffee hour to give back through service projects. Breathe in. Breathe out.

<u>Viking Vittles</u> were available to families during the summer for pickup at the Education Center Monday-Friday from 6am to 6pm. With such wide availability we expected to serve a large quantity of students that receive them during the school year. Much to our surprise distribution was much lower than anticipated.

As we start to prepare for the 2025-2026 school-year we are expecting that our numbers will be approximately the same as last year. Last year we packed an average of 285 bags each week for Phoenix, Education Center and Sunrise. In addition, St. John's packed 56 each week for the Sunrise Mobile Home Park and the middle school packed 24 bags and the high school sent 15 bags home each week. This provided 380 students will food on the weekends.

We have many very dedicated volunteers that make this possible. From picking up our order at Family Pathways each week to setting up for packing every week as well as the volunteers that deliver the totes to the schools each week. We are grateful for the students at the Life Work Center that come over weekly and pack the bags for us. Also, the confirmation students and Edge group that alternate packing one week each month. The staff at the middle school and high school that oversee the care closets making sure that the students who need Viking Vittles get them each week. If you would be interested in helping on occasion please talk with Donna Setter. We can always use extra help.

Not only does it take many hands to keep this program going, it takes many dollars as well. We have been blessed with donations from members of our congregation as well as community organizations and community members. We also apply for grants when possible. We were also blessed this year with a line item in the budget that gives us \$1000 per month. With expenses averaging \$1500 per week, we are always looking for more ways to fund this program.

Please keep the families that use Viking Vittles as well as everyone involved tin the program in your prayers.


