This October we are going to kick off year two of our Stewardship Campaign, "Pray, Play and Practice What you Preach." In year one, you all responded in a big way! Because of your pledged gifts, we were able to increase our proposed receipts for the budget by \$51,449 as compared to our 2024 budget.

The Holy Spirit has accomplished some incredible things with the funds and pledges that you offered last year. We used money in the budget to send middle school students on a Mission Trip to Duluth, MN. We funded Pizza Nights, to help bring our congregation together in fellowship and fun! We used funds to help pay for materials for an adult Bible Study on Wednesday Night. And, because of your generosity, we were able free up Phoenix funds to help support Viking Vittles to the tune of \$12,000 (projected year end total).

Your ministry dollars made a difference and with your help, we hope to keep up the momentum into 2026. Some of our goals from our last campaign are still in front of us. We would like to bring in some pastoral help in visiting and looking after our seniors and homebound members. And we still need to find ways we can reach out and invite our neighbors to share with us in the love of Christ!

There is a lot of work ahead of us, as we pray, play and practice what we preach in 2026. I know the Spirit is moving us forward and hope you will join us for the journey!




