New Year, New You

Happy New Year Trinity Lutheran!

New year, new you! Maybe you've heard that one before. This is the time of year for New Year's resolutions, where many of us promise to make those life changes that will transform us into a "better version of yourself." Eat better. Get to the gym. Lose weight. Sleep more. Spend Less. The list could go on and on and on.

Companies will be trying to sell you on these things. Diets, gym memberships, supplements, self-help books will all be marketed to you with testimonials from people who say you can become the person you have always wanted to be!

But hidden underneath all of those products is a message that is telling you that you aren't good enough. You need to change something about yourself in order to make a "better" version of you. The old you is therefore something undesirable or even unlovable.

Don't get me wrong – I think it's good to challenge yourself. It's good to have goals and work towards them. They might make you feel better, live healthier and get more out of life. There's a place for New Year's resolutions.

But this year, when you set your goals for 2026, I want you to remember something first: God loves YOU for who you already are. You don't need to change yourself in any way to make God love you more. Paul writes in Romans, "God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners, Christ died for us." Jesus didn't wait for the "new you" because he loves the old you more than you could possibly imagine or understand. Nothing you can add to yourself (or take away) could change that.

So before you make your New Year's resolution for 2026, make sure to remind yourself that God's love for you is already more than enough.




We welcome Ed Figueroa to our A/V staff!
